Planning Permission & Listed Building Consent

Our great news is that TOCT received planning permission and listed building consent to renovate and expend the Old Chapel.

We are extremely grateful to Architecton Bristol. Paul Richold, our lead designer and George Tasker his assistant have gone the extra mile in presenting imaginative and sensitive plans for the project. Historic England and David Chiplen, Conservation Officer at

West Dorset District Council have been invaluable in the development of the plans. The final building will not look dissimilar from Adrian Whittlesea's lovely original drawing.
